Authors are responsible for obtaining permission to reprint copyrighted material. Formatting requirements are posted at the site on the Submissions page:

Manuscripts must be uploaded by March 1, 2010. Authors will receive an email confirmation from the website upon successful submission of their paper. The website is built using the Open Journal System created by Stanford University.
